White Lake Marina: 2 adults, 2 chicks 5-7 days old (sightings of loons with young consistent with other years).

Howard Island: 2 adults and 1 chick 15-20 days old (sightings of loons with young consistent with other years).

Egg Shaped Bay: 2 adults no chicks.

End of Three Mile Bay: 2 adults with 2 chicks 5-7 days old (sightings of loons with young consistent with other years).

East end of Hardwood Island: 2 adults with 2 chicks, 5-7 days old.

Southwest below Hardwood Island: 2 adults no chicks.

Broadbrook Grassy area: 2 adults no chicks.

North Shore opposite McLaughlin's Island: 1 adult.

Across from Peters Point entrance to Three Mile Bay: 2 adults with 2 chicks, 7-10 days old.

Pickerel Bay Marina: 2 adults with chicks 7-10 days old (sightings of loons with young consistent with other years).

Burnt Point: 2 adults (in previous years a nesting site was located here, but washed out in 2013 with no nesting loons).

Sunset Bay: adult loons with 1 chick 3-5 days old (sightings of loons with young consistent with other years).

The total number of loons observed in 2013 were 23 adults and 16 chicks.
